What Can I Carry on JetBlue Airlines?

JetBlue allows passengers to bring:

- **1 carry-on bag** (maximum dimensions 22 x 14 x 9 inches)
- **1 personal item** (backpack, purse, laptop bag)
- Liquids must follow TSA regulations (≤ 3.4 oz per container)
- Special items like medical devices or sports equipment may be allowed

Tip: Check your ticket type, as Basic Economy fares may have stricter carry-on restrictions.

What Can You Take on JetBlue Airlines?

In addition to standard carry-on and personal items, you can bring:

- Duty-free items
- Child car seats and booster seats (must meet regulations)
- Items for medical use (with documentation)

Prohibited items include firearms, flammable liquids, and sharp objects.

Can You Change Name on Airline Ticket JetBlue?

- Minor corrections for typos are generally allowed
- Major name changes may require **cancellation and rebooking**
- Fees may apply depending on the fare type

Tip: Contact JetBlue customer service immediately to avoid complications.

Can JetBlue Rebook Me on Another Airline?

JetBlue typically rebooks passengers on **another airline only in rare cases** such as irregular operations or cancellations. Always contact JetBlue customer support for immediate assistance.

Can I Change the Name on My JetBlue Airline Ticket?

- Minor spelling errors can be corrected by JetBlue
 - Major changes often require **new booking**
 - Fees may vary depending on ticket type

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Can JetBlue Miles Be Used on Other Airlines?

No. JetBlue TrueBlue points **cannot be transferred to other airlines**. They can, however, be redeemed for **JetBlue flights or partner travel services**.

Can I Change a Nonrefundable Airline Ticket JetBlue?

- Changes are allowed, +18➤662➤843➤014➤ but may involve **change fees or fare difference**
 - Nonrefundable tickets typically receive **travel credit** instead of cash refunds
 - Check your ticket's fare rules for details

- Contact JetBlue customer service immediately
 - Correct minor spelling mistakes or typos
 - For major name changes, cancellation and rebooking may be necessary
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Are JetBlue Airline Tickets Refundable?

- **Refundable tickets:** Full cash refund
 - **Nonrefundable tickets:** Travel credit, fees may apply
 - **Blue Basic/Blue Economy:** Typically nonrefundable
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How Many Bags Can You Carry on JetBlue Airlines?

- **Carry-on:** 1 bag + 1 personal item
- **Checked bags:** Varies by fare type
- **Mint and premium cabin:** Often include free checked bags

Tip: Always check size and weight limits.
